NEGATIVE COGGINS TESTS REQUIRED!!!

All horses traveling into the state of Idaho must have a negative Coggins test for EIA within the last 6 months. Persons hauling horses must have the negative Coggins test paperwork in their possession.

The Racing Secretary will not accept entries unless all required information is supplied. If your papers are not in the Racing Office at time of entry, please have them available to you when you enter your horses. Please be prepared to provide exact information and spelling, including complete and exact works and past performances. No entries will be received except upon the condition that all disputes, claims and objections arising out of the race or respect to the condition of any race shall be decided by the Board of Stewards, and their decision upon all matters shall be final. Should an Idaho bred race not be filled at 9:30 a.m. it will then be open with Idaho Bred Preferred. No changes will be made on any race before 9:30 a.m. on any entry day. Any substitute or extra race will be used at the discretion of the Racing Secretary.

No horse will be allowed to start in any race unless all Owners and Trainers are properly licensed in the state of Idaho. No horse will be allowed to start without their foal certificates in the Racing Office prior to their race. All horses must be tattooed to start. All horses are required to have a race or official work within 45 days of race day. any horses entered in a race “around the turn” must have an official work “around the turn”.

ENTER TO RUN! As in the past, telephone scratches will be accepted. Regardless of circumstances, a scratched horse “shall remain a scratch”, and in all cases vet scratch slips will be delivered to the commission vet.

IT IS THE TRAINERS RESPONSIBILITY TO CLAIM THEIR PREFERENCE DATE AT TIME OF ENTRY!!! The Racing Office staff will provide every facility for checking allowances and eligibility. Owners and trainers are reminded that the responsibility in these matters is theirs and not that of the Racing Office. Preference Date System Rules do apply.

QUARTER HORSE OWNER TRANSFERS: Other than claiming races, a horse will be allowed to enter and run one (1) time only on a transfer. Transfers dated thirty (30) days or more will not be accepted by the Racing Secretary.

PURSE DISTRIBUTION

1ST 60% of TOTAL PURSE

2ND 25% of TOTAL PURSE

3RD 15% of TOTAL PURSE

JOCK MOUNTS AND ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE 1ST POST OF RACE DAY.
